The IMO Convention for Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS Chapter V, Regulation 23) sets out the principal requirements for the rigging of pilot ladders.

GANGWAY AT LEAST **5 METERS** ABOVE WATER






DO NOT TIE GANGWAY TO PILOT LADDER

SECURE PILOT LADDER **ON BOTH** SIDES




LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA RIGGING INFORMATION -ADDER PILOT




